



RESCUE DIVER COURSE AND SCHEDULE

The Dive Shop Rescue Diver Course is an important and crucial step in expanding a diver's knowledge and experience beyond a purely recreational level. Rescue divers learn to look beyond themselves to consider the safety and well being of other divers. This is why the Rescue Diver Course is a prerequisite to Divemaster, Assistant Instructor or Instructor.

Rescue diver training prepares student divers to help anticipate and prevent problems and, if necessary, manage dive emergencies using a variety of techniques. The course is designed to be demanding, though realistic in its conduct, content and approach. Although the nature and content of rescue training is serious, the course is enjoyable and builds diver confidence.

Who is eligible to take the course?

If you are a certified *Advanced Open Water Diver*, 15 years of age or older, you are ready for the course. A certified *Advanced Open Water* diver, 12 to 15 years old will receive a Junior Rescue Diver certification card.

Course Content

The *Rescue Diver Course* will consist of 2 classroom, 2 pool sessions and open water training exercises. You will be introduced to rescue skills in the pool and then master those rescue skills during open water training. The open water training exercises will form the foundation for dive emergency management. During our PADI Rescue Course you will need to complete the PADI e-learning rescue course on line prior to your start date.

- Floats and Ropes
- Oxygen Equipment
- First aid kit

Students need to provide

- Diving Accident Management Work Slate & pocket mask

Rental equipment is available if you do not have your own BCD, regulator system, wetsuit, etc.
